

Visiting Assistant Professor of Anthropology

Centre College invites applications for a one-year visiting assistant professor of cultural anthropology beginning August 2012. The successful candidate will teach three sections of introductory cultural anthropology, a first-year studies course during our three-week term in January, and two sections of upper-level cultural anthropology courses in the candidate's area of interest. Areas of particular interest include geographically-oriented ethnographic areas (especially Asia), medical anthropology, the anthropology of art, and psychological anthropology, though other areas will be considered. A PhD, or strong evidence that the degree will be completed before the appointment begins, and teaching experience are required.
