What is it?

The Centre Fellows Program is one way we recognize and reward some of the nation's brightest, most involved juniors.

Why should my juniors want to be one?

Centre Fellows receive a waiver of the application fee—that's \$40 saved right there! But if they're admitted to Centre, they'll receive a minimum scholarship of \$12,500 per year for four years. They'll still be considered for higher scholarships and need-based financial aid.

How do they become a Centre Fellow?

Please complete the enclosed Centre Fellows Nomination Form and attest to the following criteria:

- ❖ They're in the top 5% of their class;
- ❖ They're taking a strong college preparatory curriculum;
- ❖ They have an SAT verbal and math score of 1250 (PSAT 125) or better or an ACT score of 28 (PLAN 26) or better;
- ❖ They participate in the life of their school, community, or place of worship and would benefit from a rigorous liberal arts and sciences education

Then mail the form to us in the business reply envelope by May 1.
