- Brown Fellows Program** (full cost plus). A premier scholarship and enrichment program for highly competitive students. More information available at www.centre.edu/brownfellows.
- Bonner Program** (\$2,500 per year plus priority consideration for need-based aid). The Bonner Program recognizes students who demonstrate both financial need and outstanding commitment to community service.
- Language Scholarship** (up to \$7,500 per year). Scholarships are available to both language majors and non-majors alike and recognize advanced language skills, accomplishment and potential for leadership in language study on campus.
- LSAMP Summer Research Program** (up to \$5,000 over two summers). Scholarships are available to designated, under-represented student populations interested in science, technology, engineering and/or mathematics.
- New Horizons Scholarship** (\$19,000 per year plus priority consideration for need-based aid). Scholarships recognize students likely to provide diversity leadership on our campus.
- Performing Arts Scholarship**: music and/or drama (up to \$7,500 per year). Scholarships are available to majors and non-majors, and recognize talent, accomplishment and potential for leadership in the performing arts on our campus.
