### A commitment to the individual...

Each team is assigned 2 coaches along with a member of our lecture staff. Our student to teacher ratio is exceptional. The attention we provide to our campers is reflected in the amazing word of mouth reputation this camp enjoys. We will make you a better and smarter player.

### Commitment to development...

The Junior School was created to develop young players. The primary focus is on individual technical development with the concept of playing 4 v. 4. The Junior School reflects the Dutch Methods for training young soccer players. As important, we create a fun environment. Our philosophy is to keep the game fun for young players so they want to keep playing soccer.

### What to expect each day...

A typical day for our Junior School includes:

- 2 Technical Development Sessions with Lecture Staff & Team Coach
