FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Appropriate Attire

Often guests ask what is appropriate to wear to Commencement weekend events. Dress comfortably and wear shoes suitable for walking. Men often wear a lightweight dress slacks, a button-up and tie; women often wear either dress slacks and a blouse or a day dress.

Graduates should dress in appropriate attire under their academic regalia. We suggest that men wear a dress slacks, a button-up shirt and tie; women may wear either dress slacks and a blouse or a day dress. Hoods and mortar boards are worn at Baccalaureate and Commencement. Mortarboards are to be worn squared, not tilted, with the tassel on the right side. Stoles are not allowed to be worn for the ceremonies.

Centre Wireless Network Access

Centre's Guest Wireless Network, which will provide you with 24 hours of wireless access, can be accessed throughout campus. On your laptop or mobile device, go to your list of wireless networks. Select and join the "centreguest" wireless network. Open a browser and type in the web address of any website. When you attempt to go to the webpage you should be redirected to the **Centre Guest Portal Sign On** page (as pictured top, right). If you are having issues getting your browser to redirect to this page you may need to try navigating to more than one other web site. On the **Create Account** page fill in your first name, last name, email address, phone number and choose your SMS provider from the drop-down box. Click **Register**. You can complete your sign on by clicking the **Sign On** button at the bottom of the **Account Created** page. Last, scroll down and **accept** the acceptable use policy. *You **MUST accept** the acceptable use policy in order to be granted access to the guest wireless network.*
