Important Summer Dates and Information

This information is important for you to complete before coming to campus in August. Many of the necessary actions are time sensitive so make a note of the following information. Detailed information is on Moodle at <https://moodle-spaces.centre.edu/my/>

Start Now - Using your Centre College email account

Make your Centre email account your primary email and check it daily. This email is our primary means of communicating on campus and is required for you to log in to all of our information systems at Centre. We will be sending emails to you frequently this summer only through your Centre email address, as you can see from the information that follows. Please do not attempt to correspond with us via any other email addresses, as messages from non-Centre accounts will go directly to a SPAM folder. Contact the Centre helpdesk by emailing helpdesk@centre.edu if you have problems logging in to your Centre email account.

May 24 – June 7 - On-Line Placement Testing

You will receive an email from Dean Mary Gulley regarding online placement testing. Detailed instructions for how to complete placement testing in foreign language and mathematics will be included.

By May 31 – complete Medical History and Health Information

All first year and transfer students are required to complete or upload the following on the Student Health Patient Portal. The portal will be in the Moodle course, and active around the second week in May.

- Medical History
- Tuberculosis Screening Questionnaire
- Immunization Records
- A copy of the front and back of your insurance card

The student health office is closed during the summer however, phone messages are checked weekly.

By Wednesday June 1 - Complete the online Roommate Selection Questionnaire

The Roommate Selection Questionnaire link will be available on Moodle on May 16. If you have chosen to room with someone you know, indicate such on the Roommate Selection Questionnaire. Your chosen roommate must also indicate the same preference; otherwise you will be matched with a roommate based upon your questionnaire responses. It is important that you complete your questionnaire yourself and answer the questions honestly and thoroughly. You will select your meal plan when completing this questionnaire, so be sure to complete the entire questionnaire as soon as you can, but certainly by June 1, and you only need to complete the questionnaire once!

Around June 16 - Placement Test Results AND Fall Course Schedule available

You will receive an email from Registrar Thomas Manuel, along with information and instructions for Fall Course Registration. Students register online for courses July 11 – July 14.

Mid June – You will begin hearing from your First-Year Mentor (FYM)

This person is your peer mentor to help you with any question you may have.

June 28, 29, 30 – Call In to talk with an Advisor

You have the opportunity to speak by telephone with a faculty academic advisor about your course choices for Fall courses. Call times TBD with more information coming on this.

Week of July 11 - Housing and Roommate Information available

Look for an email giving you information on your fall housing and your roommate.

Mid to late July – you will receive a letter from EverFi announcing the 3 courses you will take

EverFi courses will begin on August 1 and will include courses on AlcoholEDU, Sexual Assault Prevention, and Diversity Equity & Inclusion.

Wednesday, August 24 - You Move to Campus

You will move into your residence hall between 8:00 am – 12:00 noon. Orientation begins that afternoon.
