THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ABOUT THE CENTRE FELLOWS PROGRAM IS FOR HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELORS.

WHAT IS IT?

The Centre Fellows Program is one way we recognize and reward some of the nation's brightest, most involved high school juniors.

WHY SHOULD MY JUNIORS WANT TO BE ONE?

If a Centre fellow is admitted to Centre, he/she will receive a minimum scholarship of \$20,000 per year for four years. Centre Fellows will still be considered for higher scholarships which, if received, will replace the Centre Fellows guarantee.

HOW DO THEY BECOME A CENTRE FELLOW?

Please complete our online Scholarship Nomination Form at admission.centre.edu/register/ScholarshipNomination and attest to the following criteria:

- They're in the top 5% of their class;
- They're taking a strong college preparatory curriculum;
- They have an SAT verbal and math score of 1250 (PSAT 125) or better or an ACT score of 28 (PLAN 26) or better;
- They participate in the life of their school, community, or place of worship and would benefit from a rigorous liberal arts and sciences education.

We accept nominations of junior students for Centre Fellows consideration through May 15. Contact your Centre admission counselor if you would like to recognize a student after this date.

HOW WILL THE STUDENTS BE NOTIFIED?

When we receive and approve your nominations, we'll send the students a letter informing them that they are a Centre Fellow. Nominators will also receive a certificate to present to the student upon approval of the nomination. Certificates take 5-7 days to process.
